

## STUDENT DROP OFF/TRAFFIC FLOW PLAN

### Zone 1 (8-12)

#### **ZONE 1 DROP OFF ONLY (NO PICK-UP) – LANE 1 (EAST SIDE OF THE BUILDING)**

*For vehicles carrying students in grade 8 through 12 seated in the rear passenger seat. Students must exit on the driver's side.*

- Grade 8-12 students enter the building at Entrance A.
- If you have a student in the front seat passenger side proceed to Zone 2.
- Vehicles that have dropped off students in Zone 1 access the through lane (Lane 2) at the staff patrolled merge point.

### Zone 2 (K-12)

#### **ZONE 2 DROP OFF AND PICK UP - LANES 1 AND 2 (NORTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING)**

*For vehicles carrying students in grades K through 12, all passengers exit and enter from the passenger side of the vehicle.*

- If there is a grade 8-12 student in the front seat or students in grade K-7 are in the vehicle, Zone 2 Drop Off is to be used.
- Two drive through lanes and two pedestrian lanes exist in Zone 2.
- Students dropped off in Zone 2 must proceed to the crosswalk and will cross the traffic lanes under the direction of safety patrols and the staff supervisor.
- Kindergarten to grade 6 students and students in grade 8 to 12 enter the school at Entrance C (Main School Entrance) through the doors on the west side of the building. Grade 7 students enter the portables on the west side of the building at Entrance B.

### Zone 3 (K-12)

#### **ZONE 3 PARKING LOT (P3) - (SOUTHWEST SIDE OF THE BUILDING)**

*Available to LCS parents that wish to enter the building.*

- LCS parents parking in Zone 3 may turn left from Lane 1 to park in P3. It is not necessary to go around the building to access the P3 parking lot.
- LCS parents who have parked in P3 may enter the building via the Grant Memorial entrance.



Of particular  
interest

- Grade 8-12 students may enter through the doors on the east side of the building as per the Zone 1 drop off guidelines.
- Vehicles may NOT use the Grant Memorial entrance as a drop off zone.
- Student drivers are to park in the southeast parking lot (P1) and enter the building via the Grant Memorial entrance at the front of the building. Students are to use caution when crossing Lane 1 and Lane 2 and heed staff direction at all times.
- All traffic must exit at via the southwest corner of the property during peak times. The south central exit lane will be closed from 8:00 - 8:45 a.m. and 3:00 - 3:45 p.m. as recommended by the Winnipeg Police Authority.

## **GENERAL**

- Zone 1, Lane 1 traffic on the east side of the building merges into Lane 2, the through lane, as vehicles proceed north past the gymnasium.
- Three options exist as drivers continue north on the single lane:
  - 1) enter Zone 2 to drop off students;
  - 2) bypass the drop off zone and parking lot using the through lane at the far north end of the parking lot to exit the property;
  - 3) park in lot P2.
- When using all drop-off lanes, pull your vehicle up as far as possible to the next stopped vehicle in the line.
- All cars exiting P2 and the through lane must yield to the cars proceeding from the drive through lanes. As in previous years, staff will be in place to manage this process. When the drive through lanes are stopped by patrols, the parking lot and through lane traffic may proceed.
- No stopping is permitted on the west drive through lane south of the merge point.
- Two-way traffic exists on the west side of the building as Lindenholm and Lindenlake Terrace occupants access their residences.
- Respect the directions provided by the safety patrols. Cars will be directed by staff members to ensure the smooth flow of traffic.
- Do not exceed the posted speed limit of 15 km/hr and proceed cautiously at all times.
- Traffic flow is greatest between 8:15 - 8:30 a.m. and 3:20 - 3:40 p.m.
